We certify that the violin, illustrated on the reverse side of this document, was made, in our judgement, by Dante Regazzoni in Cortenova Valsassina as indicated by the original label it bears dated 1980 and signed by the maker along the lower margin. On the label he has penned his initials, R D, surmounted by a cross and surrounded by two circles, in a style similar to his brand stamp. The maker has branded the instrument internally on the back above the label, on the neck block and on the belly with his characteristic monogram stamp of his initials D R beneath a cross enclosed within a single circle.

Description:

The back is two pieces of flamed maple, cut on the quarter, displaying a medium narrow figure oriented horizontally. The maple ribs and scroll have a curl with a more pronounced and narrower pattern. The belly consists of two symmetric pieces of spruce with an annual ring pattern of a variable width. The varnish is of a reddish-orange color. This violin is a representative example of the work of Dante Regazzoni for the period.
